



REQUIREMENTS FOR THE IMPORTATION OF BIOLOGICAL CONTROL ORGANISMS FROM THIRD COUNTRIES

To import biological control organisms, the following conditions must be

met: • They must be accompanied by a commercial document.

- The importer (IMP-171) must sign a declaration stating that the use of the imported products is exclusively for biological control purposes.

1. Authorized country

They may come from any country.

2. Commercial Document

The following information must appear on the Commercial Document:

- Name and address of the consignor and consignee;
- Name and address of the destination establishment;
- Country of origin;
- Control Entity (Animal species);
- Register number that appears on the MAPA web page.
- Commercial name

3. Importer's declaration

The importer shall sign a declaration in accordance with the model of this instruction (IMP-171).

EXPLANATORY NOTES:

1.-Bumblebees of genus ***Bombus spp*** are excluded from this procedure, since their import requirements are established in Regulation (EU) n° 206/2010, of the Commission, of 12th march.

2.- Any **non-viable eggs or ooquists of insects or crustaceans intended for feeding other insects** are also excluded from this procedure.
